

## **French – Key Stage Two and Three**

At KS 2 and 3, we aim to develop students' confidence, fluency and comprehension skills (grammar). We also aim to raise awareness of other cultures and therefore create a tolerant and positive attitude towards other cultures. In Years 5, 6, 7 and 8 the curriculum offers a range of opportunities for students:

- To learn about the cultural aspect of the language, such as traditions in France.
- To find out about cross-curricular aspects of the country, such as the history and the geography of France.

### **Year 5**

Students will cover topics as follows: greeting, asking and answering questions, naming school objects, saying how old they are and giving their birthday and saying what colour things are. We will talk about brothers and sisters, family and pets and also students will describing themselves and others.

### **Year 6**

Students will cover topics such as directions to places, expressing opinions, food and drinks, daily routine, giving opinions and reasons, school subjects, sports activities and what they like doing.

### **Year 7**

Students will reinforce some aspects of what they learnt at KS2 but mainly, learning will then be extended by new topics such as home life, describing their living environment, daily routine and also free time activities.

### **Year 8**

We will cover topics from going out, food, fashion, holidays, friends and relationships and pocket money to new technologies. The emphasis will also be on the 3 tenses; present, past and future.
