

Year 5 Geography.

In Geography, pupils will be taught the objectives from the national curriculum. These will be taught through different creative curriculum topics and will extend the pupil's knowledge and understanding.

The pupils will study:

- Locational knowledge –using maps to locate the countries and major cities in Europe, North and South America; the name and location of the counties and cities of the United Kingdom, including physical geographical features and the identifying the position and significance of the lines of the Tropics and the Equator, the Hemispheres, the Antarctic and Arctic Circle, and the Prime Meridian.
- Place knowledge – understanding the geographical differences between a region of the United Kingdom, a region of Europe and a region of North or South America.
- Human and physical geography – looking at physical geography and human geography.
- Geographical field work – using maps, atlases, globes and digital technology to locate countries; using the eight point compass, four and six figure grid references, symbols and keys and using field work to observe, measure, record and present human and physical features in the local area using a range of methods.
