Pupil Premium Advocate	£ 1,440.00	Children and their parents received 1:1 support from the pupil advocate to ensure their engagement in all aspects of school life.
50% of TLR payment	£1,300.00	
Family Support Worker (2.5 days per week)	£12,000.00	To provide support for disadvantaged children and their families and providing support in accessing additional services.
Pastoral and Behaviour Support for Key Stage 3 (50% of salary)	£9066.00	To provide additional daily emotional and social support to disadvantaged children. Ensuring that their behaviour did not impact their learning.
Course in London	£145.00	50% of the cost of attendance at a national conference on 'Meeting the Needs of Disadvantaged Pupils'.
Free School Meals	£3,500.00	Free School Meals and Milk was provided to support those children categorised as disadvantaged and those known to school as being financially disadvantaged but not quite eligible for FSM status.
Sports day t-shirts	£ 61.00	Children were provided a team colour t-shirt for their sports day.

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Teaching Assistant	£25250.00	Two full time teaching assistants working across the school to support disadvantaged pupils across the curriculum.
Uniform	£94.00	A school logo jumper and a PE t-shirt were provided.
School trips	£375.00	Financial contributions for pupils to attend residential school trips and day visits.
Author books	£165.00	When a visiting author visited school, a book was purchased for each child.
