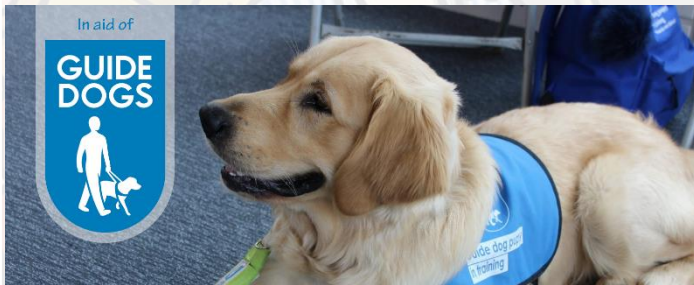

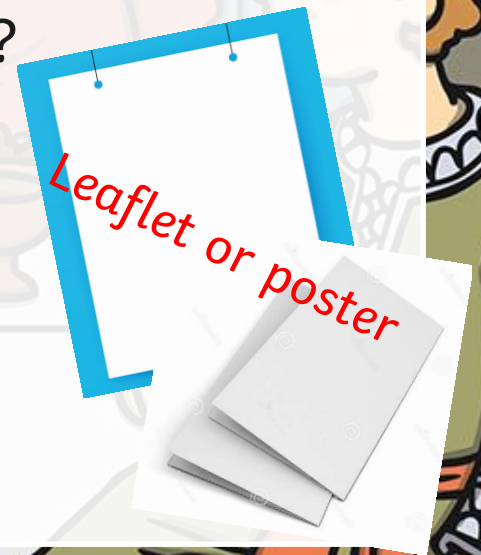
What are you sacrificing to support them?
