PE: CRICKET SKILLS

CONFIDENT CRICKETER
Equipment: bat; ball; 3 markers 1 (to place ball on and 2 to run between); notepad and pencil.
Game: Bowler bowls 3 balls to batter. The batter will strike them into playing aread, after the 3rd ball the batter should complete as many runs between the markers as possible whilst the bowler retrieves the ball back to the start position and shouts Stop!

COOL CATCHER II
Equipment: ball; wall
Activity: Stand 2m away from the wall and throw the ball against it and catch it on its return.
