Game: Set up paper targets on the wall using the tape (ideally 4 pieces at head height) with the numbers 1,2,4 and 6 written on them. Use an overarm throw to try to hit the paper target. Score: Each time you hit a target you score the amount of point written on it. How many points can you score in 12 throws? <i>#CHALLENGE: MOVE FURTHER AWAY FROM THE WALL WHAT'S YOUR SCORE NOW?</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">SKILFUL SCORER II</p> <p>Equipment: bat; selection of soft balls; 5 targets that can be knocked over. Game: Place the 5 targets on the ground 3 steps away from where you will strike the ball. Using a drop ball try to knock down all 5 targets in as few a shots as possible.</p>
